The Student Health Center provides mental health services for children pre-Kindergarten to 12th grade, and their family.

Counseling services are provided by a licensed counselor for a variety of issues, such as behavioral concerns, ADHD, substance abuse, family changes, grief and adjustments, depression or anxiety.

The Student Health Center accepts private health insurance, Medicaid and KidCare/CHIP. Patients may be eligible for discounted fees based on household size and income on a sliding fee schedule. No child will be denied services based on inability to pay.

The Student Health Center is a collaboration between Park County School District #1 and Heritage Health Center.

Appointments can be made Monday-Friday from 8:00am-4:00pm.
